The M38 Arctic Top windshield is installed and foldable ... it sure makes a big difference over 25 MPH.

I made the new "bows" from 1" EMT elbows and used 9/16" x 1" bar to mate that to the windshield frame ... heating and hammering with some drilling and welding, tapped 4 holes for 1/4"-20 screws and it all attaches and folds. I have new latches and an M38 windshield strap on order ... moving right along.

I was able to find the glass glazing at Bensinger in Dallas. Almost 100% identical rubber. The glass was about 95% scratch free and went in easy ... took a few pushes and tugs, but all went well.

Just over 360 miles right now ... having a great time with it. Took a moonlight drive with my wife, son and daughter in law last night. It was wonderful.
